

I. MoU with Kalakshetra Foundation, Chennai



Sri Sathya Sai University for Human Excellence (SSSUHE) aims to protect and revive the Indian culture and traditions. Kalakshetra Foundation was established for the preservation and promotion of Indian classical arts and craft. SSSUHE and Kalakshetra Foundation signed an MoU with the common objective to promote traditional art and crafts. As part of the MoU, SSSUHE would extend scholarships annually to deserving students at Kalakshetra from needy and underprivileged backgrounds, who would like to take up dance, music, and visual arts full-time. Kalakshetra would extend its support to BPA Fine Arts (Bharatanatyam) students of SSSUHE by conducting yearly workshops and assist with expert knowledge and would also help in tutoring/ mentoring in Vocal and Instrumental music and other visual art courses for students of SSSUHE. The collaboration between both the institutions can further extend to other aspects such as Natural Dye Research, Block Printing, Kalamkari painting, Handloom weaving, etc.

II. MoU with Sri Sri Jagadguru Shankaracharya Mahasamasthanam Dakshinamnaya Sri Sharada Peetham, Sringeri



SSSUHE and Sharada Peetham, Sringeri aim to promote, propagate and uphold the glorious tradition of Sanatana Dharma. In order to achieve this lofty ideal, both the institutions have entered into a MoU calling for mutual collaboration and cooperation. Sharada Peetham would provide guidance and support to establish a Veda Gurukulam at Sathya Sai Grama, Muddenahalli and help towards teaching and training at the Gurukulam through visiting faculty and workshops at both the premises. It would also extend guidance regarding the course content for the Vedic Studies programme of the University. SSSUHE would support the research programme and publication works of Advaita Shodha Kendra - "Advaita Sharada" to be translated into English and provide the required financial assistance towards the same.

III. MoU with Karnataka State Dr. Gangubai Hangal Music and Performing Arts University (KSGH), Mysuru

SSSUHE is focused on Academic and Research programmes of social relevance and benefit. SSSSRF is dedicated to the cause of treating congenital heart diseases and providing pediatric cardiac healthcare free of cost to the rural people. SSSUHE and SSSSRF entered into a MoU with the aim to promote mutual collaboration in advancing their academic, research and hands-on experience in the field of healthcare and contribute positively to the society. The goal of this collaboration is to encourage frequent interaction, knowledge-sharing, hands-on training, laboratory experience, diverse research and enrichment of academia. As part of the MoU, SSSUHE would support and extend financial assistance towards the medical education of the underprivileged and needy students at MGIMS with excellent academic performance. It would arrange for conduct of pediatric cardiac surgeries and interventions free of cost, for those needy children with congenital heart disease at MGIMS.

Both the institutions shall encourage exchange of scientific and technical material and facilitate joint funded/sponsored research along with hands-on-training / short research projects. SSSUHE would facilitate training of MGIMS personnel in setting up pediatric cardiology and cardiac surgery at MGIMS.
